Competitive Scholarships²

Each year, the Foresters Competitive Scholarship Program² provides over \$2 million dollars for tuition scholarships for higher learning in the U.S. and Canada. Eligible members and their families with minimum grades of 70% (Canada) or 2.8 grade point average (U.S.) and a minimum of 40 hours of community service may apply.

Foresters Community Grants Program

The Foresters Community Grants program provides members with the opportunity to apply for financial grants to organize

volunteer and fun family activities within their communities. Our members organize thousands of volunteer and fun family activities each year for other Foresters members and their families that have a positive impact on communities – and Foresters provides the tools and financial resources to do so.

Make an IMPACT

A one-time grant that will provide up to \$200 per year to help members quickly respond to urgent needs in their community. Members can apply in a just a few simple steps and are encouraged to share success stories on social media to help inspire others.

Orphan Scholarships³

This benefit may provide the children of deceased members with a renewable scholarship for higher learning for up to four years to cover tuition and maintenance. Scholarship amounts may range from \$1,500 per year to \$6,000 per year.

Terminal Illness Loan⁶: An interest free loan may be provided for an insured member who becomes terminally ill. The total

loan can be up to 75% of the total amount of the Foresters life insurance on that insured. The maximum loan amount is \$250.000.
